NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of San Bruno at their regular meeting, Tuesday, March 22, 2022, which will be called to order at 7:00 p.m. and conducted virtually, will hold a public hearing per Elections Code Section 10010 **beginning at 7:10 p.m.**, at which the City Council will consider waiving the second reading and adopting an ordinance approving the final district map for the City of San Bruno.

Hold Sixth Public Hearing, Waive Second Reading and Adopt an Ordinance to Approve a District Map and Amend Municipal Code Chapter 2.32.010 General Municipal Election.

A summary of the ordinance is as follows:

The ordinance would establish four electoral districts to comply with the California Voting Rights Act and specify the election schedule and sequence for each district. The directly elected Mayor would be retained unless changed by a vote of the people.

All interested persons are invited to attend said hearing and express opinions relating to this matter.

This meeting will be conducted telephonically pursuant to State of California Assembly Bill 361, which was signed by Governor Gavin Newsom on September 16, 2021. Accordingly, council members will be present remotely; they will not be physically present in the council chambers. Participation via electronic means is encouraged. Pursuant to AB361, the public may provide public comment by emailing comments to cityclerk@sanbruno.ca.gov before the start of the meeting.

Members of the public may view the meeting on a livestream at www.youtube.com/user/cityofsanbruno, or on CityNet Services Channel 1 or on Zoom. Online Zoom meeting details will be posted on the published agenda.
